

BIRTH MOM BILL OF RIGHTS

You have the right to be free from pressure or prejudice in exploring options concerning the birth and subsequent well-being of your child.

You have the right to confidentiality—regardless of your age.

You have the right to have help with medical and other pregnancy-related expenses.

You have the right to be put in touch with other women who have placed their children into adoptive homes.

You have the right to counseling.

You have the right to select your baby's adoptive parents.

You have the right to choose an open adoption.

You have the right to peace of mind.

You have the right to choose the type of ongoing communication with the adoptive family.

You have the right to a safe, legal, ethical, and efficient process.

You have the right to take as much time as you need to make an adoption plan.

You have the right to have an adoption resource that will stand by a child with health problems.

You have the right to send the agency updated medical and other information.

You have the right to have assistance with any communication breakdown between the birth and adoptive family.

You have the right to be told about adoption reunion and information registries.
